Below are a series of questions that you will respond to in a typed reflection paper. The writing style is personal, (you can use "I, me, my, mine, we, our, etc.), but you must use complete sentences and have thoughtful responses to these questions. Be sure to format your document so that Mr. Waddell and Mrs. Kennedy-Gibbens can easily identify which questions you are responding to. These must be typed, double spaced, printed, and in-hand at the start of class on Thursday.

You must respond to ALL of the following questions...

- 1.) What have you learned about yourself by completing this project?
- 2.) What have you learned about how media/news is created by participating in this project?
- 3.) How have these learning's shaped, influenced, or changed your worldview?

You must choose 5 questions from the list below and respond to them.

- 1.) Do I have more or less understanding or empathy than I did before this project?
- 2.) Have my sense of self, values, sense of community, willingness to serve others or self-confidence been altered through this process?
- 3.) How has this experience challenged stereotypes or prejudices I have/had?
- 4.) Will this experience change the way I act or think in the future?
- 5.) Have I given enough, opened up enough, cared enough?
- 6.) How have I challenged myself, my ideals, my philosophies, my concept of life or of the way I live?
- 7.) Was there a moment of failure, success, doubt, humor, frustration, happiness or sadness?
- 8.) Do you feel your actions had any impact? What more needs to be done?
- 9.) Has learning through experience taught you more than, less than or the same as other experiences? In what ways?
